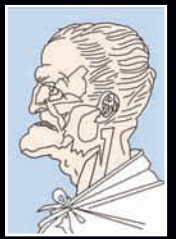

NATURAL LOOKING RESULTS, REVEALS EXTRAORDINARY BEAUTY

As far as facelifts are concerned, Park Meadows Cosmetic Surgery has taken aesthetic beauty to a new level as they have just completed renovations to their renowned facilities here in Douglas County.

As an internationally recognized practice, Park Meadows Cosmetic Surgery operations include both the practice offices and Park Meadows Outpatient Surgery (PMOS). This outpatient surgery facility was the “first of its kind” as the first state-licensed, Joint Commission (JCAHO) accredited surgical center in Colorado that is dedicated to providing cosmetic surgical procedures.

Between the two, Park Meadows Cosmetic Surgery and Park Meadows Outpatient Surgery occupy approximately 6,266 square feet. Park Meadows Cosmetic Surgery consists of a space which includes a luxurious reception area, several consultation rooms, an exam room, and a kitchen. The remodel provided a fifth consultation room to accommodate patients as well as a lavish room for the injection of dermal fillers and non-invasive procedures. A photo studio was also added to provide an area to photograph before and after procedure photos. Park Meadows Outpatient Surgery hosts two fully-equipped operating rooms and two procedure rooms. The pre-operative room, recovery room, and the private overnight patient suite are designed to offer the highest level of privacy and comfort.

While this facility and the surgeons are the backbone that makes them the destination stop for patients across the country, a visit to their website might offer the best glimpse of their extensive expertise and offerings (www.parkmeadowscosmeticsurgery.com). This site includes several dozen compelling before and after photos

and a complete rundown of the entire list of procedures and treatments performed. They participate in several social media outlets, hosting a Facebook page, a Twitter account, and a blog, updated regularly by the doctors on topics in the news.

Cosmetic Procedures account for several dozen of the available options. The four primary areas of expertise include: Body Contouring, Breast Enhancement, Facial Rejuvenation, and Hair Replacement. The most common procedures involve Breast Augmentation, Breast Lift, Breast Reduction, Implant Exchange, Tummy Tuck, Liposuction, Eyelid Surgery, Rhinoplasty, and Browlifts. Financing options are available for these procedures.

Breast Cancer patients across the country have come to know Park Meadows Cosmetic Surgery as one of the most advanced facilities of its kind. Perforator-Based Microsurgical Breast Reconstruction (DIEP Flap) is the most current and state-of-the-art in Breast Reconstruction, which uses muscle-sparing and nerve-sparing techniques to limit the damage to donor sites by harvesting only the artery and veins (the blood vessels which



“perforate” the muscles) and leaving the functional muscles in place instead of taking them with the Flap and leaving a bigger defect. Very few Plastic Surgeons take the extra time and effort to utilize this more difficult technique to limit the damage done to the abdominal and gluteal donor sites used for Breast Reconstruction. Dr Jeremy Williams and Dr Chris Williams recently completed their 100th DIEP Flap procedure, proving their center truly is one of the most-experienced in the nation.

Additional Reconstruction Procedures include: Orthognathic Jaw Surgery, Cleft-lip and Cleft Palate, TMJ / Temporomandibular Joint Surgery, Ear and Nasal Reconstruction, and Scar Revision Surgery.

Non-Invasive treatments have become common bridges to

regaining youthful skin. These treatments include Dermabrasion / Chemical Peels, BOTOX®, and Injectable Fillers. Their new injection room features a plush chair made especially for these types of procedures and has allowed additional appointments to be added throughout the day.

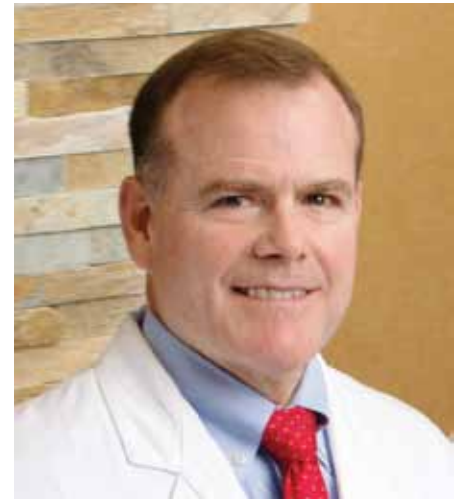

Dr. Randolph Robinson

Dr. Randolph C. Robinson is dual board-certified by the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery. He has several publications and awards related to his specialty, he holds three patents, and has achieved FDA approval on one of the bone lengthening devices.

Dr. Robinson is co-founder of FACE the Challenge (FTC), a tax-exempt organization that exists to show the compassion of Christ & provide free facial surgeries primarily for children with deformities in developing countries. He has traveled around the World to perform surgeries on children with facial deformities. Since 1993, the FTC teams have performed over 1,000 free facial surgeries.



Dr. Jeremy Williams

Dr. Jeremy Z. Williams is a Board-Certified plastic and reconstructive surgeon and is a member of the American Society of Plastic Surgeons. Dr. Williams is a Colorado native who has returned home after completing extensive training in plastic surgery at the prestigious Johns Hopkins Hospital (Ranked by US NEWS AND WORLD REPORT as Americas #1 hospital for 20 years in a row).

In addition to maintaining an active interest in various areas of reconstructive surgery, (breast, traumatic facial injuries, hand, microsurgery, and cancer reconstruction) he has specific surgical interest in aesthetic facial surgery as well as cosmetic surgery of the breast and body. He has published articles and authored book chapters on plastic surgery of the face and body. He has presented his work at numerous national and international scientific conferences.

Dr. Christopher Williams

Dr. Christopher G. Williams also attended the prestigious Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Residency program at Johns Hopkins Hospital. For eight years he studied the full range of Plastic and Reconstructive surgery including craniofacial surgery, facial trauma, microsurgical reconstruction, and aesthetic surgery.

Following his residency, Dr. Williams chose to pursue specialized training with two of the world's experts in Peripheral Nerve Surgery and Microsurgical Breast Reconstruction. He is a pioneer in the field of Tissue Engineering dedicating two years of his training to the research and the development of novel technologies for cartilage and bone repair which utilizes bone marrow derived stem cells.
